

COVID-19 Protocols

Daily Health Screening

Check every morning to see if your child has COVID-19 or flu-related symptoms. An up-to-date list of symptoms can be found at the [Province of Manitoba's About COVID-19 page](#).

Symptom and Exposure Screening Questions

Use the [self-assessment tool](#) to check if your child should be tested for COVID-19. Call Health Links at 204-788-8200 or 1-888-315-9257 if you notice symptoms or if you need more information. Screening information will be sent home for you to reference at the start of each day.

If your child develops symptoms at school, they will be isolated and you will be called. Please pick up your child promptly. Make sure the school has your current contact information and a back-up to call if you can't be reached.

Chronic Conditions

Communication of a Confirmed COVID-19 Case

- The school will be informed by Public Health when there is a positive case in a school.
- The school administration will communicate with parents and the school community.
- Public Health may provide additional information.
